Public Transport:

Airports

The airports of Düsseldorf, Cologne and Brussels are in a one hour driving distance, the smaller airports Maastricht-Aachen and Mönchengladbach are in a 30 to 45 minutes distance.

Trains

Aachen can be reached comfortably by train. The easiest train connection is from Düsseldorf airport. Direct trains run hourly from the airport to Aachen central station (Hauptbahnhof, Hbf). From Cologne you have to take a regional train to Cologne central station (Hauptbahnhof), where you can change to Intercity (IC) or Regionalbahn (both leave hourly) to Aachen Hbf.

In Aachen

From Aachen Hbf you can take a taxi for ~12-15€. The driver may not know the new street name "Otto-Blumenthal-Str." Yet, so you may have to tell him the former name "Huyskensweg".

Alternatively you can take bus No. 3 or 13 (departing from Aachen Hbf entrance) to bus stop 'Ponttor'. Change to bus No. 33 (direction 'Klinikum') there and get off at bus stop 'Forum'. From there, you can already see the AMICA building with its glass dome.



Otto-Blumenthal-Str.

By Car:

From Cologne (A4) or Düsseldorf (A44): At motorway intersection 'Autobahnkreuz Aachen' drive motorway A4 in direction Antwerpen (Antwerp). Exit the motorway at 'Aachen-Laurensberg' and turn right (Kohlscheider Straße). Pass a traffic light straight ahead and then turn right onto the 'Außenring/Toledo Ring' (direction 'Klinikum'). Follow this road to the second exit ('RWTH Melaten'). At the intersection drive straight ahead. The next street to the right is Otto-Blumenthal-Straße (formerly Huyskensweg). Follow this street to the end, where you will see the AMICA building. Please take note that you may need to enter Huyskensweg into your navigation system, because most of the software is not updated with the new street name yet.
